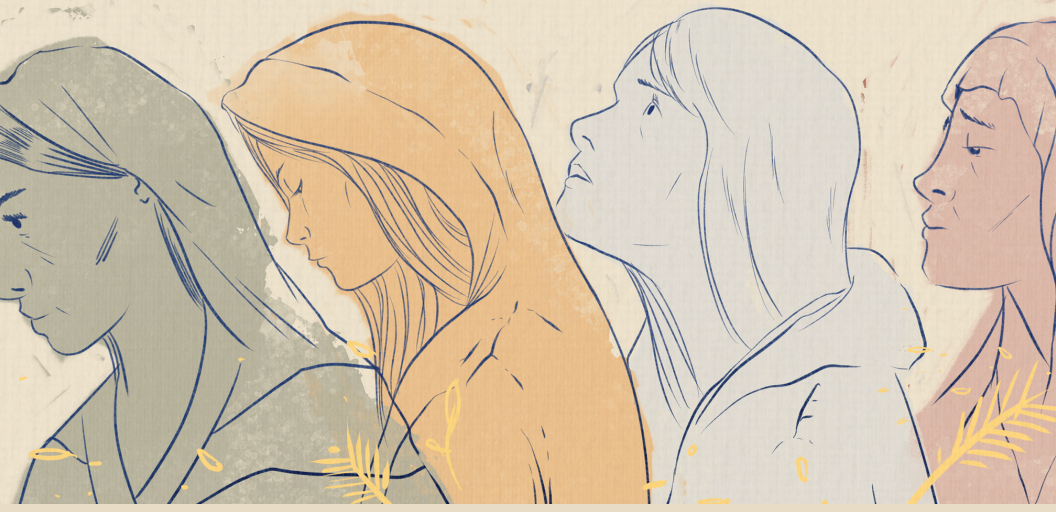

# REAL WOMEN

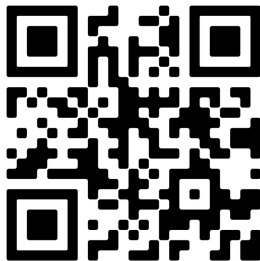

**#2 Personal Reflection:** We can only get as close to God as our concept of Him will allow. If we carry pain but don't see Him as loving, then we won't pray for Him to heal or comfort us. ## Discussion Questions (Mary)

**#1 Discussion:** A hallmark of being a woman of faith is desiring to obey and submit to God, our Father who loves and guides us. Mary's faith was so extraordinary that, even as a teenager, she submitted to God's request to birth and raise Jesus! We might be prone to worship her for such incredible obedience, yet her response and example was to worship God, not herself. Discuss instances where God asked you to be obedient yet you struggled with fear, approval of others, and/or questioned His will and love for you.

**#2 Personal Reflection:** Put yourself in Mary's place and ask yourself, thru prayer and reflection, how you respond to those areas in your life where there is pain and uncertainty? How can you "treasure God's word in your heart" on a regular basis? Do you believe God loves you, and trust His authority and path for your life? If not, confess those things to Him and ask that He would grow your faith as you spend time with Him.

# Discussion Questions (Widow of Zarephath)

**#1 Discussion:** What part of the Widow's story can you relate to? How has God miraculously provided for you (physically, emotionally, spiritually)? Pray to thank the Lord for His provision.

**#2 Personal Reflection:** The Widow was blessed physically by God not allowing the oil and flour to run out until the drought was over. God cares about all our needs, but especially our spiritual life. The Widow didn't seem to believe who God was until after He gave Elijah the power to bring her son back to life, saying, "Now I know that you are a man of God, and that the word of the Lord in your mouth is truth." Are there areas that you are still expecting more from God, to prove Himself, so that you will believe in who He is? (ex if I get this job, I will believe God provides; if my husband \_\_\_\_\_, I will believe God is good; if my friend doesn't betray me, then I will believe God cares). Confess ways you have wavered in trusting God's character and love for you, then offer thanks that He is Jehovah Jireh (God will provide).
